## Executive Order N-10-25- Property Tax Relief for Wildfire Survivors

### To Our Community,

In the wake of the devastating wildfires that have touched so many lives in Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, Governor Gavin Newsom has issued **Executive Order N-10-25** to provide relief to affected property owners.

#### What This Means for You:

If your home or property is in an impacted area, this executive order suspends penalties, interest, and fees on late property tax payments due in 2025. This grace period extends until April 10, 2026, giving you time to focus on healing, rebuilding, and moving forward.

#### Who Is Eligible?

This order applies to properties in ZIP codes affected by the fires, including: 90019, 90041, 90049, 90066, 90265, 90272, 90290, 90402, 91001, 91040, 91104, 91106, 91107, 93535, and 93536.

#### You Are Not Alone.

We understand that recovering from a wildfire is more than just rebuilding—it's reclaiming a sense of security and stability. This order is designed to ease financial stress so you can focus on what matters most: your family, your home, and your well-being.
